



# MyGoldCloud Cookie Policy

## What are cookies?

MyGoldCloud's website uses cookies to collect information. Cookies are small data files which are placed on your computer or other mobile or handheld device (such as smartphone or tablets) as you browse the website. They are used to 'remember' when your computer or device accesses this website. The cookies are essential to the effective operation of this website and to enable you to shop with us online.

## What information is collected?

Some cookies collect information about browsing and purchasing behaviour by people who access this website via the same computer or device. This includes information about pages viewed, products purchased, and the customer journey around the website. A cookie may contain information (such as a unique user ID) that is used to track the pages of the sites you've visited. MyGoldCloud uses this information to analyse trends, to measure the number of visitors to our site and to help make our website easier to use and navigate. Note that we do not use cookies to collect or record personally identifiable information such as a user's name, address or other contact details. You can set your browser to refuse cookies, but if you do, you might not be able to take full advantage of this website.

We use third parties to assist us in measuring statistical information about visitors to our website. Such parties may utilize cookies or web beacons, but in no event will they connect any individual user with personally identifiable information or share any such information with anyone else.

## Who sets the cookies?

The cookies stored on your computer or other device when you access this website are set by MyGoldCloud / third parties.

## What are cookies used for?

The main purposes for which cookies are used are:

1. Technical purposes essential to the effective operation of this website.
2. To enable MyGoldCloud to collect information about the browsing and purchasing habits of customers.

## How do I disable cookies?

If you want to disable cookies, you need to change your web browser settings to reject cookies. How to do this will depend on the browser you use. We provide further detail below on how to disable cookies for the most popular browsers:



**For Microsoft Internet Explorer:**

1. Open the **Tools** menu and select **Internet Options**.
2. Click the **Privacy** tab.
3. Choose the desired setting, then click **OK** to apply your settings.

**For Mozilla firefox:**

1. Open the **Tools** menu and select **Options**.
2. Click the **Privacy** tab or icon.
3. Locate the **Cookie** or **Accept third-party cookies** menu and choose the desired option.
4. Click **OK** to apply your settings.

**For Google Chrome:**

1. Open the **Customize and control Google Chrome** menu and select **Settings**.
2. Click **Show Advanced Settings...**
3. Click **Content Settings...** and choose the desired option.
4. Click **Done** to apply your settings.

What happens if I disable cookies?

**This depends on which cookies you disable, but in general the website may not operate properly if cookies are disabled. If you only disable third party cookies, you will not be prevented from making purchases on this website.**
